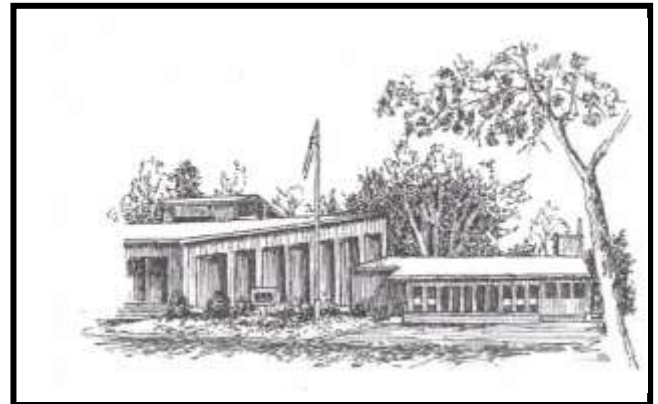

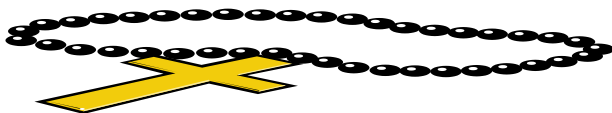
THRIFT STORE UPDATE

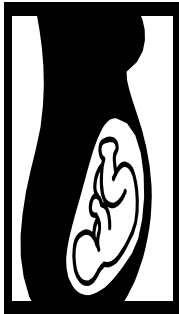
